

Council Meeting
Town of Nutter Fort

Mayor Maxson invited attendees to join in prayer offered by William Benincosa, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Maxson called the meeting to order in council chambers at 6:30 pm.

Attendance: Mayor Sam Maxson, Recorder Charlene Louk, Councilors William Benincosa, Bruce Kidd, Karen Phillips and Brenda Riley.

Maintenance Dept : The roof on the maintenance building was approximately 20 years old and in very poor condition. Extensive repairs and a new roof are nearly complete. Work is being done by town maintenance staff.

Public Comment: Linda Blake from the Beautification Committee asked about the new town entrance signs. Mayor Maxson reported the signs are in and will be installed soon. Linda would like more space for flowers to be visible around the sign on Rt. 20 (entering town from the Clarksburg side). It was noted that the signs are larger and space at this site is limited. Also, it will be difficult to install the sign on Rt. 98 closer to the actual town border due to solid rock. Chief Godwin mentioned asking Chris D'Annunzio if the sign could be installed near his gate. This would be closer to the town boundary than the current sign location. He and Mayor Maxson will ask Mr. D'Annunzio.
